Membership Fees

The membership fee for new & existing members is **\$225** which pays for the year-end banquet and the prize table.

Old Friends + New Members + New Courses = Good Times and Great Golf

The Ongoing Challenge We Face.

Gone are the days when golf courses practically fell all over themselves to accommodate clubs such as ours. Not only are they now demanding higher and higher deposits to reserve space for Sunday tournaments, but each year also there are fewer and fewer courses willing to accommodate Sunday tournaments. Consequently, our Club's relationship, reputation and integrity that has been cultivated and fostered over the years with many of these courses must be protected at all costs. Showing up late for tournaments (or not showing up at all) threatens this relationship because it ultimately means the golf course is unable to maximize the number of golfers they can accommodate and reflects badly on our Club. Please be a responsible player.

COMMITTING TO TOURNAMENTS BUT NOT SHOWING UP

Once again, we will require all members to complete the tournament commitment form enclosed. If you commit to a tournament and are not able to attend, you **MUST** notify **FRANK CLIVIO: 416-624-2363** or e-mail: <u>frankclivio@rogers.com</u> a minimum of **8 days** in advance. You may also schedule additional guests (space permitting) by contacting Frank 8 days in advance. Please be aware that you are responsible for their attendance (please note penalties outlined below).

*******Previous years there continued to be several instances where members either showed up late (after first scheduled tee off time) or didn't show up as committed without proper notification. To protect the Club's reputation your Executive Committee has ruled that the following penalty will apply:

Committing to Tournaments but not showing up, without 8-day notification – A **\$20.00** penalty (payable to the Treasurer) will be assessed. *If you fail to notify Frank Clivio of your inability to attend, you will be responsible for any costs (in addition to the* **\$20.00** penalty) assessed by the Golf Course. The penalty will be waived if you arrange for another golfer to attend in your absence.

Members failing to pay Club penalties will not be permitted to attend the year-end banquet and waive their rights to year-end trophies and prizes.

Please note, as in the past, we will only allow a complete foursome to book a tee-off time if all members have paid. As well, once a foursome is set, we will not substitute players. This ensures that golfers who arrive early are not left teeing off last.

MEMBER GUEST RULE

WHGA Member's are privileged to exclusive rates and deals from our partner golf courses. If others wish to enjoy the perks and benefits, then they must join. Therefore, the WHGA Executive has implemented some new rules for guest play.

- 1) Guest must be invited by active member (min. 1-week notice) and play with that member.
- 2) Guest can only play 3 tournaments. (They must join if they want to play in more events)
- 3) Guest are only allowed to participate if there is availability.

WEST HILL GOLF ASOCIATION CLUB RULES

General play falls under the RCGA rules of golf with the following exceptions:

RULES:

- MAX SCORE DOUBLE PAR!!!
- LOCAL RULINGS: Only apply when notified by the Executive Committee prior to the round of golf.
- Drop Areas are allowed.
- NO MULLIGANS!! NO HOULAHANS!! NO DO-OVERS!!
- Flag in or out, Double Hit no penalty, Drops from Knee Height, Plugged in bunker (1 stroke to drop in bunker & 2 strokes if removed from bunker & dropped behind bunker, no closer to the pin).
- West Hill Fairway Rule: At all times, players are allowed to <u>ROLL</u> their ball no closer to the hole on their own fairway. With the use of the golf club. Do not touch the ball with your hands.
- Winter rules: May apply as applicable when announced.
- **Playing in Rough:** Play ball as it is found in the rough.
- Out of Bounds from the Tee: Play a new ball, under penalty of 1 (one) stroke, at any point along the imaginary line between where you hit it from and where it went OB. You have the option of re-teeing the ball and count 3 off the tee.
- Lost Ball (Hazard)/Environmental Area: Drop a ball two club lengths from point of entry or anywhere on your line provided it is no closer to the hole, under penalty of 1 (one) stroke.
- No "Gimmies": Hole out all putts.
- **No Waving Up:** Do not wave up players onto par 3's.
- **3rd Tournament Prize Eligibility:** New members' prize eligibility to begin upon completion of their 3rd tournament played. Also, returning members that did not play in the league the year prior must establish a new handicap.
- **Unpaid Membership Dues:** Members are not eligible for tournament prizes.
- Slow Play: If members are instructed (by course officials) to skip one or more holes due to slow play they become ineligible for prize monies or trophies for that tournament.
- **Count All Shots:** This rule is for the benefit of all players. Please play fair and count all shots.

Rules To Live By:

As you know golf is a gentleman's game and, as such, we must govern ourselves accordingly. Members who act inappropriately, disobeying local rules, golf course rules, or provincial laws also jeopardize our Club's reputation. **We will not allow the few to affect the majority.** Any breach in these rules (laws) will be severely frowned upon. The Executive Committee will review any breach brought to our attention and respond appropriately. Please respect our Club, our rules, and our reputation. Smoking (any type) where not permitted, offensive language, drinking of alcohol where not permitted, (remember most courses restrict the bringing of alcohol onto their courses) or any unsportsmanlike conduct is strictly forbidden. By following these simple and common-sense rules the Club, and its members, will continue to enjoy the rights and privileges of playing golf at our selected courses.

We would like to remind all members that **ALL** golf courses require soft spikes and have dress codes. Please do not wear track pants, shorts without pockets, cut-offs, shirts without collars, or jeans. These are course rules and we must abide by them.

PLAY READY GOLF - KEEP PACE OF PLAY

- Have your club in hand and be ready when it is your turn to hit;
- Take a few clubs if you are unsure which one you might need;
- Employ continuous putting whenever possible;
- Read your putt while others are making theirs;
- Hit your shot when the group in front is safely out of the way;
- Drop playing partner off at their ball and continue on to yours.

HANDICAPPING (NO FLIGHTS)

All players will play from the white tee blocks for the entire year.

SENIOR EXEMPTION: We have implemented a senior exemption. All those members who are 65 and over will have the option to play the from the forward tees. YOU MUST tell one of the Executives or the Statistician prior to your start if you choose this. Those seniors that choose this option, must reestablish their handicap from these blocks before they are eligible to compete for points and awards.

All new members or returning members that did not play in any tournaments in the 2024 year must play in 3 tournaments to establish a league handicap before they are eligible to compete for points and awards.

Handicaps will be carried from the 2024-year end for members joining this year.

THERE ARE NO MORE FLIGHTS. WE ARE A 100% HANDICAP LEAGUE. TOP 4 LOW NET PLAYERS WILL RECEIVE 3 POINTS EACH. PLACES 5 THRU 8 WILL RECEIVE 2 POINTS EACH.

PLUS ALL PLAYERS WILL ALSO RECEIVE 3 POINTS FOR EVERY TOURNAMENT PLAYED.

Instead of Trophies, we will be awarding Low Net for 1st thru 4th.

1st Place Low Net = \$20 2nd Place Low Net = \$20 3rd Place Low Net = \$20 4th Place Low Net = \$20

The person with the most points at the end of the year receives the first choice of the prize table at the year-end banquet.

HANDICAPPING INFORMATION

We will continue the live handicap for each individual player. Your handicap will be evolving throughout the year as your tournament scores are posted.

In addition to the information posted on our web site, an E-mail reminder will be sent to all members by the **Thursday** before each tournament outlining 1) Location of next tournament 2) First tee-off time 3) Green Fee cost 4) Extra's included at tournament (i.e.: gift, food, driving range...).

We will be awarding individual Cash Prizes for the **Top 4 Low Net only** and points will be awarded for the top 8 places for **Low Net** scores.

TORNAMENT WIN ELIGIBILITY

New Members: In order to establish a league handicap, new members must play in three tournaments.

Returning Members:

- Returning members are eligible for winners' points and prizes from the first tournament.
- Returning members that did not play any tournaments last year must re-establish a handicap over the first three tournaments to be eligible for prizes and points.

All Members: to be eligible for the year-end awards (Mike Bonnah Award, etc.) you must attend at least **4** of the **10** individually scored tournaments. However, handicaps will continue to be based on the full year's play (4Man Event and year-end tournaments are not included in individual tourney).

THE VENUE FOR THE 2025 AWAY WEEKEND

We will be heading to **Woodland Links Golf Course** in Clinton. This year it will take place on the weekend of August 8th – 10th. For the members who have never attended, this is truly a **<u>Must Attend Event!</u>** The fun, the camaraderie, the rewards and the good times had by all, are second to none. **PLAN TO ATTEND THIS EXTRAVAGANZA.... you won't regret it!!**

50/50 DRAW FOR EACH TOURNAMENT

There will be a 50/50 draw at the end of each tournament instead of the traditional "door prize". **Participation is optional**. The cost will be **\$ 20.00** payable via e-transfer to <u>whgadeposit@outlook.com</u> by the Friday prior to the tournament. This draw will enable the club to maintain our low membership dues. Half of proceeds will go to the winner with half going to the club for enhanced prizes at the end of the year. **You do not need to be there for the draw.** Monies won will be e-transferred to the winner.

4-Man Event

THIS IS ALSO A "MUST ATTEND" EVENT!!!

The 4-man Event will take place on **June 29**th at **Watson's Glen Golf Course**. The format will be explained at the tournament prior to the start of the event. In order to participate, the Treasurer must receive the Event fee of **\$50.00** per person (i.e., \$200/team) no later than **June 1**st (the **Black Diamond Golf Course** event) via e-transfer. In the case that a team has only 3 golfers that day, the cost will be **\$66.67** per person. Once the teams are finalized the Executives will notify the players that will need to pay the correct fees.

The cost includes the \$10.00 charge for "Closest to the Pins" prizes. In order to qualify, returning members must attend 3 of the first 5 tournaments and new members must have played in at least 3 tournaments to establish their handicap. Teams tee offs will be drawn one hour before the tournament begins.

WEEKEND AWAY

Handicapping for the Away Weekend

We will be utilizing a live handicap system for this event **and the Double Par Rule will not** apply for the Weekend Away. Considerable monies are at stake and your Executive wants to ensure fairness for all members. This measure will prevent the possibility of anyone inflating their handicap prior to the event and shooting at a much higher level during the 2-day tournament. This year teams will be formed, anchoring the top and bottom (based on handicap) and draw for the middle member. These teams will be either 3 or 4 man teams based on attendance.

WOODLANDS LINKS GOLF CLUB

As the name suggests, Woodlands Links is a links-style golf course on natural rolling terrain and forested areas. At **6,950 yards**, it is a championship layout with three sets of tees that provide a variety of challenges for the low and high handicap player alike. The course has water in play on **eleven** holes and sand and grass bunkers are strategically placed to make you think your way around. It has been called a shot-maker's course with no two holes alike and golfers will be required to play every club in their bag. Woodlands Links also provides golfers a chance to work on their game with a practice range featuring four irrigated greens at various distances as well as a putting and chipping green. After your round, you are invited to sit back and enjoy the wholesome fare in the unique clubhouse which is designed from the existing 162-year-old post beam barn.

- **3** Rounds of golf including power cart: (range balls are not included, inquiry about pricing)
- Breakfast (bacon, eggs, home fries, toast and coffee) on both Saturday and Sunday at the • qolf course;
- Lunch consisting of hamburger, fries, salads and pop at the golf course on Sunday;
- Shared accommodations:
 - Note: There are only a few single rooms available on a first come first served basis. The first 24 deposits are guaranteed rooms at the Bedford.

- Closest to the pin (Saturday & Sunday), Friday is optional, \$10 each collected Friday morning; •
- Cash Prizes for top 4 players (based on 2 day combined low net scores);
- Gratuities for golf course staff;
- Dinner on Friday is a delicious steak dinner, served at the golf course after the round.

You will pay the league \$395 for the weekend away.

Accommodations are paid directly to the hotel. Shared accommodation cost is \$139+ taxes per golfer for the two nights. Single accommodation cost is \$318+ taxes per golfer for the two nights.

Note:

Our first tee time on Friday is 10:30am, Saturday is 10:30am and Sunday is 9:00am.

There will be a 50/50 Draw on all 3 days of the event. Participants will be able to purchase for **\$20.00** each day by paying the \$60 Friday morning.

Why A Liability Waiver Is Required

In 2003, several legal precedents were set in which golfers successfully sued clubs and/or courses for personal injury and/or property damages, even though these golfers were intoxicated or otherwise incapacitated at the time of the incident. In each case a *Liability Waiver* was not in place holding golfers solely responsible for their behavior and/or actions resulting in damages or injury while being intoxicated or otherwise incapacitated. All courses are now insisting that such a *Liability Waiver* be in place for all tournaments/events.

LIABILITY WAIVER

The **undersigned** hereby acknowledges and agrees to hold **WHGA Executive Members** and Golf Course/Club Management/Owners harmless/blameless against any and all liability, loss, personal injury, property damage, cost or expense whatsoever resulting from the **undersigned** being intoxicated or otherwise incapacitated while participating in **WHGA** sponsored tournaments/events.

The undersigned further acknowledges and agrees to follow and abide by all **WHGA** and Golf Course rules and regulations while participating in WHGA sponsored tournaments/events.

The WGHA reserves the right to;

- (1)Request that members or guests that fail to abide by said rules or regulations remove themselves from the golf course immediately;
- (2) Revoke, without compensation, the membership of any member who has, in the judgment of the **WHGA Executive**, seriously jeopardized the integrity and/or reputation of the **WHGA** while participating in **WHGA** sponsored tournaments/events.
